

# ARBORVITAE

## **Brandon**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Brandon'*

12-16' x 6-8'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Narrow, cone-shaped growth habit with densely branched, bright green foliage that retains its color even during harsh winters. Good resistance to winter burn and tolerates heavy soil. Excellent for screening.



## **Dark Green**

*Thuja occidentalis 'nigra'*

18-24' x 8-10'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Improved pyramidal form and dense, fan-shaped foliage that retains its rich, dark green color better during the winter. Excellent screen or large hedge. Size can be controlled with annual pruning. Moist, well-drained soil.



## **Degroot's Spire**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Degroot's Spire'*

10-12' x 3-4'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Dwarf, slow-growing, upright pyramidal form and a twisted texture. Thick, rich green foliage takes on a purple cast in winter. Tolerates shearing for a more tailored column.



## **Golden Globe**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Golden Globe'*

4' x 4'

Sun/light shade Zone 4

Very dense globe with a beautiful golden yellow color on the outside and nice bright green in the interior section. Coloration will darken to bronze during winter weather but remains quite attractive.



## **Hetz Mini**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Mini'*

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Low, compact globe with dense, rich green needles that are arranged in flat layered sprays. Slow growing and does not require pruning to maintain shape. Very adaptable, tough, and durable.



## **Hetz Wintergreen**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Hetz Wintergreen'*

20-25' x 6-8'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

This fast growing Arborvitae remains green year round (no winter bronze tones) and makes a great screen or conical accent. Grows with a strong leader and is able to withstand heavy snow loads without splitting.



# ARBORVITAE

## **Holmstrup**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Holmstrup'*

10-12' x 5'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Dense, narrow-pyramidal shape with attractive rich green scale-like foliage in vertical sprays. Foliage retains good green color throughout winter. Slow growing, prefers moist, well-drained soil.



## **Little Giant**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Little Giant'*

4-5' x 4-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

This compact globe has rich green foliage year round. Its slow growth rate allows it to retain its neat, round shape with little maintenance.



## **Mr. Bowling Ball®**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Bobozam'*

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Unique, finely textured, soft sage-green foliage forms a perfect compact globe that does not require pruning or shearing to maintain shape. Slow growing; prefers well-drained soil.



## **North Pole®**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Art Boe' PP 22,174*

12' x 5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Tight, columnar growth habit with dark green foliage that is resistant to winter burn. Cold hardy and low maintenance. Light pruning as needed to maintain shape.

## **Planet Earth™**

*Thuja occidentalis 'RutThu4' PPAF*

3-5' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

This dense globe has bright green foliage in the summer that takes on bronze tones in the winter. It doesn't need pruning to maintain shape. Resistant to needle blight and winter burn.

## **Primo®**

*Thuja occidentalis 'IslPrim'*

4' x 1'

Sun/light shade Zone 4

A mini arborvitae that has a naturally sculpted, spire-like growth habit and richly textured foliage. The green foliage takes on a bronze tone in winter. It develops into an elegant small tree at maturity.



# ARBORVITAE

## **Pyramidal**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Pyramidalis'*

12-25' x 3-6'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Narrow pyramidal form is decidedly crisp without shearing, about half as wide as the species. Soft textured, bright green foliage appears lush and dense. A tough, yet elegant evergreen that prefers winter shade.



## **Rushmore**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Rushmore'*

12-20' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Tough and adaptable upright evergreen with dense dark green foliage that is resistant to winter burn. It's narrow form makes a great hedge or screen. Very cold and wind tolerant. Shear once a year to maintain shape.



## **Technito®**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Bailjohn' PP 15,850*

8-10' x 4-5'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

A slow growing, compact, pyramidal form that requires very little shearing to maintain shape. Dense, dark green foliage retains its attractive color through the winter.



## **Techny**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Techny'*

15-20' x 8-10'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Broadly based pyramidal form has dense foliage that maintains its handsome dark green coloring all year. Excellent for medium to tall hedges or screens. Grows best in well-drained, loamy soils.



## **Techny Globe**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Techny Globe'*

5'+ x 5'+

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Dense, dark green foliage of a Techny, sheared into a globe form. Requires regular pruning to maintain shape and size. Grows best in well-drained, loamy soils.



## **Woodward Globe**

*Thuja occidentalis 'Woodwardii'*

3-5' x 4-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Compact globe to spreading form with attractive scale-like rich green foliage in flattened sprays. Does not need shearing to maintain globe shape. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



# ARBORVITAE

## **Yellow Ribbon**

*Thuja occidentalis* 'Yellow Ribbon'

8-10' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Very narrow, columnar growth habit with showy, dense golden-yellow foliage all year. Used as an accent or screen where brilliant color is needed. Very adaptable; best in well-drained, loamy soils with consistent moisture.



# CEDAR

## **Eastern Red**

*Juniperus virginiana*

30-40' x 10-12'

Full sun

Zone 2

Broad, cone shaped evergreen with medium green foliage year round. In late summer and fall, many have blue-green berry-like fruits, actually modified cones, that attract birds. Typically long lived, very hardy, and low maintenance. Salt tolerant. Native.



# CHAMAECYPARIS

**Jade Waves™ Fernsray**     *Chamaecyparis obtusa 'MonYur'* PP 29,503

6-8' x 3-4'

Full sun

Zone 4

An improved selection with a more compact, uniform habit on an attractive pyramidal form. Branches curve gracefully and hold sprays of fern-like green foliage that takes on a bronze hue in winter. Does best in well-drained soil and protection from harsh wind.



**King's Gold**

*Chamaecyparis pisifera 'King's Gold'*

4-5' x 4-5'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Compact and spreading growth habit with threadlike foliage. Its brilliant golden color is retained throughout the year, even in heat and humidity. Grows best in well-drained soil.



# FIR

## **Balsam**

*Abies balsamea*

45-60' x 20-25'

Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Upright, pyramidal form with flat, shiny, dark green needles with a strong balsam scent. A favorite for Christmas trees, and provides shelter for birds and animals. Native.



## **Concolor**

*Abies concolor*

30-50' x 15-30'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Upright, densely conical with attractive, blue-green needles that curve outward and upward on branches and when crushed, emit a lemon scent. Tolerates drought, heat, and cold temperatures. Requires well-drained soil.



## **Piccolo Dwarf Balsam**

*Abies balsamea 'Piccolo'*

2-3' x 2-3'

Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Tiny, uniform, dark green needles radiate around the many short branches on this dwarf globe Balsam Fir variety. Plant in rich, acidic soil where it can be viewed up close.



## **Tyler Blue Balsam**

*Abies balsamea 'Tyler Blue'*

15-18' x 10-12'

Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Lush blue foliage on a fairly compact, pyramidal form. Needles are soft and maintain their distinctively blue color in sun or part shade with well-drained soil. Slower growing, measuring 8-10' tall & 4-5' wide after 10 years.



# HEMLOCK

## **Canadian**

*Tsuga canadensis*

30-45' x 20-30'

Sun/shade

Zone 4

Pyramidal growth, branches often droop with soft, glossy, dark green needles. Long-lived tree that does well in city conditions, and prefers well-drained soil. Native.



## **Emerald Fountain®**

*Tsuga canadensis* 'Monler'

6-10' x 2-3'

Sun/shade

Zone 4

Compact, slow-growing cultivar that forms a bushy column of dark green foliage that is attractive throughout the year. Should be protected from winter sun to prevent sun scald.



## **Golden Duchess®**

*Tsuga canadensis* 'MonKinn' PP 25,503

3-4' x 3-5'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Dwarf, low mounding form with bright golden yellow foliage on graceful, arching branches. Foliage has improved sun tolerance over other gold varieties. Prefers slightly acidic, moist, well-drained soil.



## **Moon Frost**

*Tsuga canadensis* 'Moon Frost'

3' x 3'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Dwarf, mounded to globose with bright white new growth and older green inner foliage retains light tones giving the plant an overall whitish appearance. In winter, the white foliage is blushed with pink.





# JUNIPER

## **Andorra Compact**

*Juniperus horizontalis* 'Compacta'

18" x 3-5'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Handsome, tightly branching form creates a ground cover versatile for use in rock gardens and in the foreground of borders. Bright green foliage turns a plum color in winter.



## **Blue Arrow Upright**

*Juniperus virginiana* 'Blue Arrow'

12-15' x 2'

Sun/light shade Zone 4

Bright blue foliage on tight, narrow, upright form makes a beautiful background. Ideal for spatially challenged screening. Silvery blue berries are produced from late spring into early winter.



## **Blue Chip**

*Juniperus horizontalis* 'Blue Chip'

8-10" x 4-6'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Silver-blue foliage on a widely spreading, compact habit. Foliage retains its color all year long but with purplish tips in the winter. Drought tolerant.



## **Blue Forest**

*Juniperus sabina* 'Blue Forest'

12-15" x 3'

Sun/light shade Zone 3

Ascending branches form a miniature "blue forest." Blue color is maintained year round. Its flat and spreading habit makes it a great choice for rock gardens and as a groundcover in small sites.



## **Blue Point Upright**

*Juniperus chinensis* 'Blue Point'

10-14' x 6-8'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Upright, broadly pyramidal form with dense, blue-green foliage requires little to no pruning. Fast growing; can withstand drought and windy conditions better than other uprights. Holds its color throughout the winter.



## **Blue Star**

*Juniperus squamata* 'Blue Star'

2' x 4'

Sun/light shade Zone 4

Attractive sparkling steel blue foliage on dense spreading and mounding branches. Often used as a rock garden or low border plant.



# JUNIPER

## **Blueberry Delight®**

*Juniper communis depressa 'AniDak'*

12" x 4'

Full Sun

Zone 3

A densely spreading juniper that has dark green needles with silvery-blue hues. Foliage turns bronze in fall and winter with small blue cones that resemble blueberries. Drought tolerant and deer resistant.



## **Buffalo**

*Juniperus sabina 'Buffalo'*

12-18" x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Soft, feathery branches with an interesting low spreading form. Bright green foliage, retains good color in winter. Excellent as a groundcover. It is very hardy and salt tolerant.



## **Calgary Carpet®**

*Juniperus sabina 'Monna'*

9-12" x 6-8'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Low and wide spreading with soft green foliage makes this a great choice for groundcover or erosion control. Very durable evergreen that withstands cold, heat, and drought.



## **Daub's Frosted**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Daub's Frosted'*

3-4' x 3-4'

Full Sun

Zone 4

An unusually low growing pfitzer that retains the graceful habit of its more upright relatives. Visually exciting two tone effect created as tops of blue green foliage is frosted with gold.



## **Grey Owl**

*Juniperus virginiana 'Grey Owl'*

2' x 4'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Feathery textured foliage is a smoky blue-gray and holds its color well in winter. Produces an abundance of silvery berries, often used for winter decorations. A spreader good for hot, poor, or dry soil.



## **Hetz Columnar Upright**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Hetzii Columnaris'*

15-18' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Upright juniper with a dense growth habit and columnar to pyramidal shape. Bright green foliage can be left unsheared or easily shaped with pruning. Works well as a screen, background planting, or topiary.



# JUNIPER

## **Hughes**

*Juniperus horizontalis 'Hughes'*

12-18" x 6-8'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Wide spreading, graceful branches retain its silver-blue foliage color through winter. It is adaptable to snow and frost, as well as, excessive heat. Works well for erosion control on steep slopes.



## **Medora Upright**

*Juniperus scopulorum 'Medora'*

10-12' x 3-5'

Full Sun

Zone 3

A slender-shaped variety with a blue-green color. Needs little shearing to produce a narrow-columnar specimen. Slow growing and very durable. Tolerates heat, cold, and drought.



## **Moonglow Upright**

*Juniperus scopulorum 'Moonglow'*

18-20' x 6-8'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Flashy, soft-textured, silvery-blue foliage on a dense, compact-branching, pyramidal form. It produces attractive silver-blue berries from late spring to late winter. Very adaptable to wet or dry soil. Deer-resistant.



## **Pencil Point Upright**

*Juniperus communis 'Pencil Point'*

6-8' x 1-2'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Very narrow, upright columnar form featuring very tight, blue-green foliage. Cold hardy, tolerant of poor soil, urban pollution, and remains tight and neat without pruning.



## **Pompon**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Monlep'*

4-6' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Mint Julep® pruned into a topiary with globes on branch ends. Attractive mint-green foliage on graceful, fountain-like arching branches. The foliage darkens in cold weather. Prune regularly to maintain topiary shape.



## **Scandia**

*Juniperus sabina 'Scandia'*

12-18" x 6-8'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Gracefully spreading, densely branched groundcover useful for border or rock garden accent. Holds its bright green color well through winter. Drought tolerant and very durable.



# JUNIPER

## **Sea of Gold**

*Juniperus x pfitzeriana 'Sea of Gold'*

3' x 4'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Outstanding lacy, golden-yellow foliage makes this compact evergreen an excellent choice as a colorful accent. Color is retained and deepens in winter better than other gold-tipped varieties.



## **Sea Green**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Monlep'*

4-6' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Attractive mint-green foliage on graceful, fountain-like arching branches. The foliage darkens in cold weather. Ideal bank cover for erosion control and often used in topiary forms due to its adaptability.



## **Skyrocket Upright**

*Juniperus virginiana 'Skyrocket'*

12-15' x 2-3'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Very narrow, columnar form with silvery blue foliage. Durable and versatile with a moderate growth rate. Adapts to a wide variety of site conditions. Plant in groups as a screen or alone as an accent.



## **Spartan Upright**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Spartan'*

15' x 3-5'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Dark green foliage that maintains a symmetrical, pyramidal shape without pruning. Makes a great hedge, windbreak, or formal column. Fast growing, heat and drought tolerant.



## **Spiral**

*Juniperus chinensis 'Monlep'*

4-6' x 2-4'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Mint Julep® pruned into a spiral topiary. Attractive mint-green foliage that darkens in cold weather. Requires regular pruning to maintain spiral shape.



## **Taylor Upright**

*Juniperus virginiana 'Taylor'*

25' x 3'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Narrow and columnar with semi-soft blue-green needles which give it an elegant and refined look. It maintains a more dense, upright form than others. Adaptable to many soil types.



# JUNIPER

## **Wichita Blue Upright**

*Juniperus scopulorum* 'Wichita Blue'

12-15' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Broadly pyramidal form makes this perfect for screens, hedges, background plant, or lawn specimen. Retains brilliant silvery-blue color all year and does not produce berries. Rugged and reliable.



## **Wilton Blue Rug**

*Juniperus horizontalis* 'Wiltoni'

4-6" x 3-5'

Sun/light shade

Zone 3

A trailing juniper having a uniform, full centered growth habit with intense silvery-blue foliage. Tips turn purple in winter. Excellent use as a groundcover or for cascading over walls. Heat and cold tolerant.



# LARCH (Tamarack)

**American**

*Larix laricina*

40-50' x 15-30'

Full sun

Zone 3

This deciduous conifer has light blue-green needles that turn a brilliant golden color in the fall and then drop. In the spring they green up at the same rate as leafy deciduous trees. They have an upright, pyramidal shape. Native.



# MICROBIOTA

## **Russian Cypress**

*Microbiota decussata*

12-18" x 3-4'

Sun/shade

Zone 2

A dwarf, densely branched evergreen with low spreading, bright green summer color turning bronze-purple in winter. Very hardy. Resembles a spreading juniper, but with softer, feathery foliage. Available as a shrub or grafted onto a standard tree form.



# PINE

## **Austrian**

*Pinus nigra*

50-60' x 30-40'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Darkest green pine with an upright, broadly pyramidal form. Heavy, long needles with a strong pine fragrance. Vigorous, dense grower. Tolerates heat, cold, and adverse conditions. Very hardy; good for windbreaks.



## **Blue Shag White**

*Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag'*

4-6' x 5-7'

Sun/light shade

Zone 3

Dwarf eastern white pine with outstanding, compact, reliably rounded form with short, blue green needles that are soft to the touch. Adaptable to a wide range of soil conditions.



## **Carsten's Wintergold Mugo** *Pinus mugo 'Carsten's Wintergold'*

9-15" x 18-24"

Full Sun

Zone 2

Low mound of striking golden-yellow needles in the winter which are green the rest of the year. Slow growing and very cold hardy. Best in well-drained soil.



## **Dwarf Mugo**

*Pinus mugo pumillo*

6-8' x 8-10'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Attractive mounded shape that can be maintained by pruning. Especially nice in early summer when new 'candles' of growth appear. Dark green needles; very hardy and rugged.



## **Fastigiata White**

*Pinus strobus 'Fastigiata'*

30-40' x 10-15'

Full sun

Zone 3

Fast growing, narrow columnar with ascending branches. Dense blue-green foliage is soft to touch and works well as a windbreak or screen. Does best in moist, well-drained soil.



## **Frank's Columnar Austrian** *Pinus nigra 'Frank'*

12' x 4-6'

Sun

Zone 2

Slow-growing, narrowly columnar selection of Austrian pine. Dark green needles are smaller and very prickly. Branching is very upright and held tight against the plant. White buds add fall and winter interest.





# PINE

## **Hindu Pan Scotch**

*Pinus sylvestris*

40-50' x 20-30'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Scotch Pine pruned into a Hindu Pan topiary. Blue-green twisted needles and irregular branching on a broad, upright crown. A medium sized, fast growing pine with distinctive flaking orange/red-brown bark.



## **Mini Twist White**

*Pinus strobus 'Mini Twist'*

2-4' x 3-4'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Compact form of white pine with soft-textured blue green needles that twist. It forms a globe when young and grows wider with age. This very unique conifer is slow growing and prefers well-drained soil.



## **Norway (Red)**

*Pinus resinosa*

50-80' x 30-40'

Sun/light shade

Zone 2

Referred to as Red Pine due to the red colored bark. Broad, upright form with an oval to rounded crown. Sharply pointed needles are yellow-green to dark-green, bundles of two, and brittle. Native; state tree of MN.



## **Scotch**

*Pinus sylvestris*

40-60' x 30-40'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Blue-green twisted needles and irregular branching on a broad, upright crown. A medium sized, fast growing pine with distinctive flaking orange/red-brown bark. Best grown in moist, acidic, well-drained soil.



## **Scotch Dwarf Pom Pom**

*Pinus sylvestris 'Glauca Nana'*

6' x 6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Rich blue-green needles -pruned into pompoms, on dense, horizontal branches. Has attractive reddish bark. A slow-grower that requires regular pruning to maintain topiary form.



## **Slowmound Mugo**

*Pinus mugo 'Slowmound'*

3' x 3'

Sun/light shade

Zone 2

Dwarf selection that forms a dark green, dense mound and won't outgrow its planting space. Attractive, white buds are present in the spring. Very cold hardy and drought tolerant once established.



# PINE

## **Stowe Pillar White**

*Pinus strobus* 'Stowe Pillar'

15-20' x 4-5'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Narrow columnar with dense foliage of long, bluish-green needles. Tight branching makes it more resistant to wet snow loads. Deer and rabbit resistant and verticillium wilt resistant. Prefers moist, well-drained soil.



## **Swiss Stone Algonquin Pillar** *Pinus cembra* 'Algonquin Pillar'

15-16' x 6-7'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Uniform growth habit that is pyramidal and upright. Two-toned, silver-green needles are retained better than other pines. Low maintenance.



## **Swiss Stone Blue**

*Pinus cembra* 'Glauca'

12-18' x 10-15'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Upright, columnar habit that is densely branched to the ground. Attractive silvery-blue needles have green undersides. Foliage is highly ornamental and remains blue throughout the winter. Relatively low maintenance.



## **Swiss Stone Chalet**

*Pinus cembra* 'Chalet'

10-15' x 3-6'

Full Sun

Zone 4

Dense, narrowly conical growth habit with clusters of soft, blue-green needles with white undersides that remain attractive all year long. Colorful cones add to its character. Slow growing.



## **Swiss Stone Prairie Statesman®** *Pinus cembra* 'Herman'

25-30' x 10-15'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Strong central leader with lateral branches that curve upward and slightly inward resulting in a narrow, dense growth habit. Foliage is a rich emerald green with silvery-blue overtones.



## **Swiss Stone Silver Whispers™** *Pinus cembra* 'Klein'

12' x 6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Compact, dense pyramidal form with white-striped dark green needles that have a silvery effect and are accented with 3-inch long decorative violet-blue cones.



# PINE

**Swiss Stone Westerstede** *Pinus cembra 'Westerstede'*

12' x 8'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Broad, graceful branching habit. Long, luxurious, blue-green needles give it a full, fluffy appearance. Little pruning needed to stay in scale. Striking cones provide year-round beauty. Disease and pest resistant.



**Tannenbaum Mugo** *Pinus mugo 'Tannenbaum'*

10-12' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Cone-shaped in youth, becoming more pyramidal with age. It maintains its lower branches and retains its attractive dark green color all year long. Very cold hardy.



**Weeping Angel Falls White** *Pinus strobus 'Angel Falls'*

6-10' x 2-3'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Slower growing with denser branching than the standard weeping White. This upright weeper has long, soft, blue-green needles making it a unique focal point. Height depends on training. Moist, well-drained soil.



**White** *Pinus strobus*

50-75' x 25-40'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Open to loosely pyramidal as a young tree and becoming gnarled and more irregular with age. Soft, blue-green needles appear in bundles of five. Fast growing when planted in fertile soils. Native.



# SPRUCE

## **Baby Blue Eyes**

*Picea pungens 'Baby Blue Eyes'*

18-20' x 8-10'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Broad, pyramidal form that does not require pruning. Striking silvery-blue foliage is resistant to needle cast. Very slow growing, only 2-3" per year. Prefers rich, well-drained soil.



## **Bird's Nest**

*Picea abies 'Nidiformis'*

3' x 2-3'

Sun/light shade

Zone 3

Tight, many layered branches create nest-like compact form with light green needles. Versatile, cold hardy, and requires little maintenance. Japanese Beetle resistant.



## **Black Hills**

*Picea glauca densata*

25-35' x 20-30'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Upright pyramidal to dense symmetrical cone shape with bright-green needles that mature to an interesting blue-green. Shears easily and is useful as a specimen, hedge, or windbreak.



## **Blue Totem**

*Picea pungens 'Blue Totem'*

12-15' x 2-3'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Branches fork upwards at a sharp angle, creating a very tight, narrowly upright growth habit. Vivid powdery blue needles remain bluish-green throughout the winter. Low maintenance and deer resistant.



## **Bonny Blue**

*Picea pungens 'Bonny Blue'*

25-30' x 15-20'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Beautiful short blue needles stand out on this perfectly shaped, slow growing spruce tree. It has a strong central leader and a pyramidal form. Foliage remains silvery-blue throughout the winter.



## **Colorado**

*Picea pungens*

40-60' x 15-30'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Symmetrical, pyramidal form with rigid tiered branches densely covered with stiff gray-green to blue-green needles. Excellent as a specimen, hedge, or windbreak. Likes fully exposed, well drained locations.



# SPRUCE

## **Cupressina Norway**

*Picea abies 'Cupressina'*

20-30' x 8-10'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

A narrow, pyramidal selection of Norway Spruce with a dense growth habit. Needles are dark green year round. Branches are strong enough to handle heavy snow without breaking. Shows good deer resistance.



## **Dwarf Alberta**

*Picea glauca 'Conica'*

5-6' x 3-4'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

A perfect cone shaped dwarf conifer with dense gray-green needles. Excellent as a container plant or miniature Christmas tree. Needs some winter protection in zone 4 in exposed areas.



## **Dwarf Blue Globe**

*Picea pungens 'Globosa'*

3-5' x 5-6'

Full Sun Zone 2

Dwarf, flat-topped, densely branched globe with bright blue needles all year but are brighter in summer. A unique accent for that special spot. Available in shrub form or grafted onto a standard.



## **Dwarf Norway Globe**

*Picea abies 'Pumila'*

3-4' x 3-4'

Sun/part shade Zone 3

Attractive, broad globe with interesting light to dark green needles covering dense branches. Spreading habit useful as an informal hedge or landscape accent. Does well in colder climates.



## **Fastigiata Colorado Blue**

*Picea pungens 'Fastigiata'*

12-15' x 4-6'

Full Sun Zone 3

Powdery blue foliage on an upright, narrow, columnar habit when young but becomes more broadly pyramidal over time. Branches can be kept tight with shearing.



## **Fat Albert**

*Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'*

30-40' x 18-20'

Full Sun Zone 3

Growth habit is similar to a Colorado Blue Spruce with more consistent blue coloring. When young, it can appear very wide and rounded. Prefers rich, moist soil.



# SPRUCE

## **Meyeri**

*Picea meyeri*

40-50' x 15-20'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

More disease resistant and versatile spruce tree with dense, green to blue needles and a symmetrical, upright pyramidal form. It has a medium growth habit and is tolerant of urban locations and dry conditions.



## **North Star**

*Picea glauca 'North Star'*

8' x 5'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Compact tree with a dense habit and the classic pyramidal form with longer, medium-green needles. Has good resistance to winter wind and sun burn. Faster growth rate than other dwarf varieties.



## **Norway**

*Picea abies*

60-80' x 25-30'

Full Sun

Zone 2

A large, pyramidal spruce with slightly upturned primary branches and slightly weeping secondary branches. Needles are deep green and four sided. Established trees are drought tolerant and deer resistant.



## **Sester's Dwarf**

*Picea pungens 'Sester's Dwarf'*

5' x 4'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Stunning blue needles, slow growth rate, and classic conical form make this dwarf spruce an ideal plant for the modern landscape. Excellent as a specimen for small landscapes. Very cold hardy.



## **Sherwood Compact**

*Picea abies 'Sherwood Compact'*

8-15' x 5-8'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Upright, pyramidal, dwarf Norway selection with green needles and light brown shoots. Ascending branch habit and a narrow, conical shape. New spring foliage emerges light green. Low maintenance.



## **Skinny Blue Genes™**

*Picea glauca var. densata 'Westervelt' PP 29,825*

25' x 8'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Narrow, conical growth habit with rich blue needles. Tolerant of very cold conditions, as well as, drought and deer.



# SPRUCE

## **Weeping Norway**

*Picea abies 'Pendula'*

5-12' x 4-6'

Full Sun

Zone 3

Height is dependent on training. Slow growing with pendulous branches. Excellent as a specimen or in rock gardens. The shape varies from tree to tree. Dark green needles year round. Drought tolerant.



## **Weeping White**

*Picea glauca 'Pendula'*

20-30' x 4'

Full Sun

Zone 2

Narrow, upright, weeping habit that does not require staking to maintain its form. Dark blue-green to gray-green needles on the stiff, strongly weeping side branches give it a formal appearance. Very cold hardy.



## **Whiskey Blue Hills**

*Picea glauca densata 'Whiskey Blue Hills'*

15-20' x 6-8'

Sun/part shade

Zone 2

Semi-compact, pyramidal form with very blue needles. Disease resistant and extremely cold hardy. This slow to medium growing variety reaches approximately 10' tall and 6' wide in ten years time.



# YEW

## **Emerald Spreader**

*Taxus cuspidata 'Monloo' PP 10,335*

2' x 8-10'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

The ideal low maintenance choice for large scale ground cover and embankment plantings or low hedges. Retains dark green foliage color in the coldest of winters. Red berries in winter.



## **Everlow**

*Taxus x media 'Everlow'*

2-3' x 4-5'

Sun/shade Zone 4

Low growing with striking green needles that are resistant to winter burn. It has a slow growth rate and maintains its short stature with little pruning. Showy red fruit. More sun tolerant than other cultivars.



## **Nana Aurescens**

*Taxus cuspidata 'Nana Aurescens'*

2' x 5-6'

Sun/shade Zone 4

Low spreading with brilliant gold new growth which contrasts beautifully with the dark green older foliage. Slow growth rate and easy to maintain. Male cultivar that does not produce fruit. Very adaptable.



## **Nova**

*Taxus cuspidata 'Nova'*

6' x 3'

Part sun/shade Zone 4

A slow growing, upright yew with dark green foliage and red berries in fall. Does well with shearing or can be left naturally shaggy. Long lived and tolerant of urban conditions.



## **Taunton**

*Taxus x media 'Tauntoni'*

3-4' x 4-5'

Part sun/shade Zone 4

Spreading form with dark green needles great for hedges, screens and foundation plantings. Noted for its resistance to winter burn and tolerance of summer heat. Red berries.



## **Upright Capitata**

*Taxus cuspidata 'Capitata'*

12-15' x 5-6'

Part sun/shade Zone 4

Dense, upright form with rich, dark green foliage. Tolerates shearing and can be used as a trimmed 8-10 foot hedge. Requires good drainage. Slow growing.
