APPLE

FirestormTM Honeycrisp Malus 'Firestorm Honeycrisp'

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

A highly colored red strain of Honeycrisp. It retains the same characteristics as the original. It ripens in late September with small, very sweet, crisp, juicy fruit. Developed by the University of Minnesota.



15' x 12-15' Full Sun Zone 3

Medium-sized deep red fruit are hard, firm and tart, bearing fruit in early October. Fire blight resistant and cold hardy. Stores well and is good for cooking, baking, and fresh eating.



15-20' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 3

This variety produces large, tart apples that are very firm. The medium sized fruit ripens in early October and is red in color. The trees are very cold hardy and the apples store well.

Honeycrisp Malus Honeycrisp'

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

Exceptionally crisp and juicy, flavor is sweet but well-balanced. Blooms mid-season and ripens in late September. Excellent storage life, up to 7 months.

Honeygold Malus 'Honeygold'

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 3

Fruits are golden-yellowish-green with a bronze blush. Flowers in late season and ripens in early October. Fruit is sweet and stores well. Cold hardy to -50 degrees.

KinderKrisp Malus 'KinderKrisp' PP 25,453

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4


Small, red fruit is sweet, crisp, and juicy. Early season bloomer that ripes in late August. Very disease resistant. Dessert apple developed by David MacGregor of Fairhaven Farms located in South Haven, Minnesota.













APPLE

McIntosh Malus 'McIntosh'

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

Red and green skin, tart flavor, and tender white flesh. Blooms mid-season and ripens in late September. A heavy and reliable cropper that achieves its best flavor in colder applegrowing regions.



Snow Sweet® Malus Windung'

12-15' x 14' Full Sun Zone 4

Sweet and tart flavor is outstanding. Really crisp and juicy. Fruits are large and reddish-bronze. Flesh is very white and slow to oxidize when exposed to air. Blooms mid-season and ripens mid to late September.



State Fair Malus 'State Fair'

12-15' x 12-15' Full Sun Zone 4

An excellent all purpose, medium-sized apple with red striped skin. Sweet and tart, good for eating and baking. Has a short storage life. An early season bloomer that ripens in mid to late August.



Sweet Sixteen Malus 'Sweet Sixteen'

10-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4


One of the best for fresh-off-the-tree eating, Super sweet with a richly complex flavor—similar to vanilla with just a hint of molasses and fine bourbon. Blooms mid season and ripens mid September.



Zestar!® Malus 'Zestar!'

10-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

Very crisp and juicy with an above average sweet/tart flavor. Mostly red on a yellow background. It will store well for several weeks after being picked. Early season bloomer that ripens mid to late August.



BLUEBERRY

Chippewa Vaccinium corymbosum 'Chippewa'

3-4' x 2' Sun/light shade Zone 3

A self-fruitful selection developed by the University of Minnesota. It produces high yields of fruit in August that are firm and sweet. It has an upright growth habit with glossy green foliage that turns orange-red in fall.



Duke Vaccinium Duke'

4-6' x 4-5' Sun/light shade Zone 4

An early-season variety that is high-yielding and hardy. The attractive fruit is medium to large, light blue, and slightly tart. Glossy dark green foliage turns orange-red in fall. Plant in evenly moist, acidic soil.



Northblue Vaccinium x Northblue'

2' x 4-6' Sun/part shade Zone 4

Low growing with showy white flowers that are tinged with pink. Large, dark blue fruit is a prolific, mid-season producer. Self-fruitful. Green summer foliage gives way to a striking display of yellow, orange, and red in fall.



Patriot Vaccinium Patriot'

4-6' x 4-5' Sun/light shade Zone 4

Profusion of pink-tinged white flowers produce an early crop of very large, firm, sweet blueberries. Dark green foliage has lovely yellow, bronze and red fall color. Excellent as a hedge or specimen.



Polaris Vaccinium Polaris'

3-4' x 3-4' Sun/light shade Zone 3

Noted for its tight form, dense foliage, and larger yields of medium sized, sweet fruit in July and early August. White bell-shaped flowers cover the plant in early May and orange red foliage in the fall.



CHERRY

Evans Bali Prunus cerasus 'Evans Bali'

12' x 6-8' Full Sun Zone 3

Showy white flowers in spring are followed by loads of bright red cherries in midsummer. Sweeter than other sour cherries; self-pollinating. The dark green leaves turn an outstanding orange in the fall.



North Star Prunus 'North Star'

10-12' x 6-8' Full Sun Zone 4

This tart cherry that is a heavy bearer of bright red, small-stone fruits in August. A genetic dwarf variety that is self-fruitful. Short stature makes for easier cherry picking.



Sweet Cherry PieTM Prunus 'Eubank'

15' x 8-12' Full Sun Zone 4

The sweetest of the sour cherry varieties. It is an early season bloomer that ripens in mid-July. Self-fruitful and compact size make it great for a home garden or small orchard.





CRABAPPLE

Chestnut Malus 'Chestnut'

12-16' x 10-15' Full Sun Zone 3

Early to mid season blooms produce large, edible reddish-bronze 2" fruit with a sweet, juicy, nut-like flavor in late August. Cold hardy and disease resistant introduction from the University of Minnesota. Useful pollinator for other early to mid season bloomers.



PEACH

Contender Prunus x 'Contender'

12-15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

Cold hardy and tolerant to late-spring frosts. Marvelously melting, sweet, yellow flesh. Early May blooms produce extra-juicy freestone fruit that ripens in mid to late August. Self-pollinating.



Reliance Prunus persica 'Reliance'

12-14' x 12-14' Full Sun Zone 4

Soft pink blooms in mid to late spring are followed by a heavy crop of medium-sized, mild and sweet fruit that is firm and freestone with red-blushed yellow skin. Reliably cold hardy, vigorous and fast growing.



PEAR

Early Gold Pyrus x Jefgold' COPF

25' x 20' Full Sun Zone 3

Abundant showy white flowers in spring produce fruit with a consistent oval shape, small, high quality, greenish fruit in early August. Very resistant to fire blight. Performs best with a pollinator.



Golden Spice Pyrus ussuriensis 'Golden Spice'

18' x 12' Full Sun Zone 3

White flowers in spring produce small, firm, yellow w/light blush fruit that ripens in late August. The pears have a sweet taste and a crisp texture. Self-pollinating, but will have a higher yield with a pollinator. Fire blight resistant.



Parker Pyrus Parker'

15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

Open-pollinated seedling of a Manchurian pear has white flowers in spring. Large, yellow-bronze fruit in August is fine grained, tender and juicy. Upright and vigorous grower.



Summercrisp *Pyrus 'Summercrisp'*

15' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 4

May flowers produce fruit in August when crisp and still green with a red blush. Fruit is sweet and crisp, and may be stored up to 2 months. An annual bearer that is free of fire blight. Use Parker as pollinator.



PLUM

BlackIce Prunus 'Lydecker'

8-12' x 8-10' Full Sun Zone 4

Late spring flowers produce large, purple-black fruit in early August. Semi-clingstone; size and yield is comparable to popular conventional cultivars. Naturally compact growth habit makes it easy to manage.



Mount Royal Prunus 'Mount Royal'

8-12' x 6-8' Full Sun Zone 4

A Blue European Plum that is good eaten right off the tree. Tender and juicy, self-fruitful freestone. Blooms in May and ripens in late August. Considered the best blue cultivar in Wisconsin and Minnesota.



Toka Prunus Toka'

15-20' x 10-12' Full Sun Zone 3

One of the best pollinators. A medium sized, richly flavored clingstone variety with beautiful apricot-red color. Flowers late April to early May and plums ripen in Mid-August.



RASPBERRY

Caroline Rubus 'Caroline'

3-4' x 3-4' Full Sun Zone 4

Superior flavor and bigger yields. Two bumper crops of sweet, firm red raspberries; first in late June and then from August till frost. Very vigorous variety, with more tolerance for root rot. Everbearing and self-fruitful.



Heritage Rubus 'Heritage'

3-4' x 3-4' Full Sun Zone 4

This everbearing dark red raspberry has two harvest seasons, with a moderate yield in July and heavy yield in September until frost. Self-fertile and fast spreading. Typically bears fruit in its first year.
