# **CLEMATIS**

Boulevard® Acropolus<sup>TM</sup> Clematis Evipo078' PPAF

3-4' x 2'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Bright magenta pink blooms with deeper magenta veining. Blooming starts in early summer and blooms again in later summer. Compact growth habit produces full, bushy vines. More shade tolerant than other clematis.

#### Boulevard® Nubia

Clematis 'Evipo079' PPAF Sun/part shade Zone 4

3-5' x 2'

Bright red flowers bloom from June into August and again in September. Prized for its easy care and bushy long-blooming compact habit. Enjoyed by butterflies and other pollinators. Prune hard in the spring to encourage reblooming and to maintain tidy habit.

Doctor Ruppel	Clematis 'Doctor Ruppel'	
6-10' x 3-4'	Sun/shade	Zone 4

Delicately ruffled, pale pink flowers with a darker center bar, bloom first in late spring and summer, then again in fall. A shade tolerant variety with attractive green foliage.

#### Jackmanii

10-12' x 5-6'

Clematis x jackmanii

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Vigorous climber with continuous blooms of large, deep purple flowers with prominent, creamy-yellow stamens from June through September. Performs best in rich, welldrained, mulched soil.

### Paniculata

Clematis paniculata

20' x 5-10'

Sun/part shade Zone 4

Pure white, slightly fragrant, blooms cover this twining vine from August through September. Fluffy silvery seed heads amass the plant in fall. Late to emerge in spring but vigorous and easy to grow. Thrives in part shade with rich, well-drained, mulched soil.











## **CLEMATIS**

#### Pink Champagne

Clematis Kakio'

8' x 4'

Sun/part shade

Zone 4

Pink to magenta flowers with pale mid-ribs bloom in May and June and rebloom in August and September. This clinging, twining vine has green foliage and does best in welldrained, mulched soil.

Toki

Clematis x 'Toki'

5-9' x 5-6'

Sun/part shade

Early blooming. Large, pure white flowers with yellow stamens in spring and a rebloom in late summer. Green foliage with a vigorous, clinging, twining growth habit. Best in rich, well-drained, mulched soil.





## HONEYSUCKLE

**Dropmore Scarlet** Lonicera × brownie 'Dropmore Scarlet'

8-12' x 6-8' Sun/part shade

Zone 3

Compact twining vine with clusters of showy, tubular bright orange to scarlet flowers from June to September and are followed by long lasting red berries. Attractive bluegreen foliage is dense and fast growing.



### <u>IVY</u>

Boston

Parthenocissus tricuspidata

Sun/shade

40-50" x 25'

Sun/shade

Zone 4

Self clinging, dense climber with shiny, dark green, lobed leaves that turn a brilliant scarlet in fall. Blue-black berries appear in late summer into fall. Great for erosion control or cover for brick or stone walls.

Engelman

30-40" x 20-25'

Zone 4

Parthenocissus quinquefolia 'Engelmannii'

Self clinging, vigorous climber with dark green leaves that turn scarlet to burgundy in fall. Small bluish-black berries are often hidden until after the leaves drop in fall. Requires very little care; prefers well-drained soil.
